The Fulbright Scholar Program offers opportunities for American college and university faculty and administrators as well as for professionals, artists, journalists, scientists, lawyers, independent scholars, and many others to conduct teaching or research projects in Taiwan.

U.S.-Taiwan International Education Administrators (IEA) Award

Goal: International Education administrators in universities/ colleges come to Taiwan to explore the opportunities of establishing cooperation with local institutions by visiting various sites in 2 weeks.





AWARDS FOR U.S. STUDENTS

English-taught Master's Degree Program Awards

Awards are for 2 years to **Master's** degree studies **taught in English**, with the opportunity to **learn Mandarin** supported by Critical Language Enhancement Award (**CLEA**).

The award provides grantees with a 100% tuition waiver, campus housing, a monthly stipend, National Health Insurance, and round-trip airfare.

Eligibility: At least a Bachelor's degree at time of matriculation



Agricultural Economics

✔ National Taiwan University
(國立臺灣大學)

Providing courses in:

- 1) Policy, Regulation and Legislation
- 2) Agricultural Marketing, Trade and Consumption
- 3) Production and Agri-business Management
- 4) Resource and Environment Economics



Asia-Pacific Studies

✔ National Chengchi University
(國立政治大學)

Providing courses focusing on either Taiwan or China and fall under one of three disciplinary tracks: political economy, socio-cultural studies, or cross-strait/international relations.



Political Economy

✔ National Tsing Hua University

Preparing talented students for leadership positions in international organizations, government, business and civil society institutions.



Diplomacy

✔ National Chengchi University

(國立政治大學)

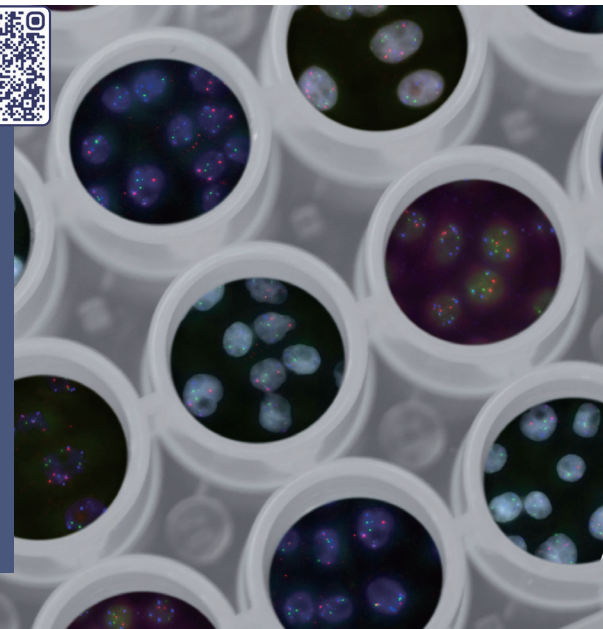
Focusing on cross-cultural communication studies with an additional emphasis on the Asia-Pacific area.

(國立臺灣師範大學)

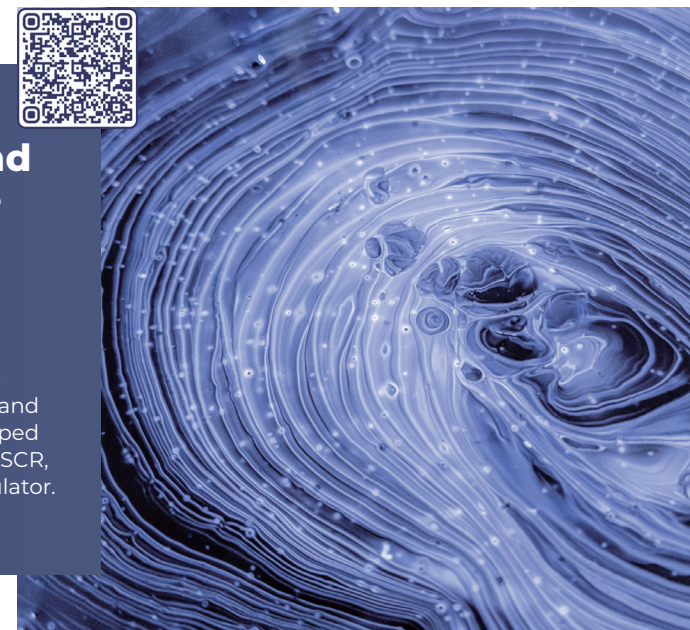
Featured with international and cross-cultural environment, versatile career prospects, connection to the leading industries in Taiwan, and easy access to Chinese language and culture learning.

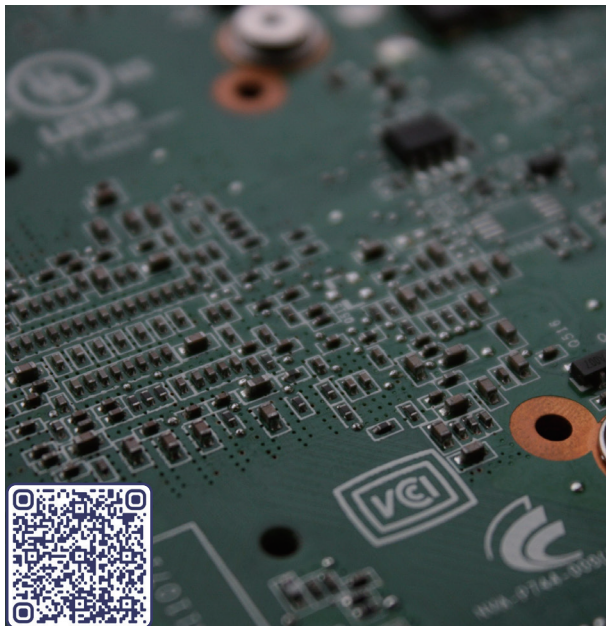


Semiconductor Technology

AWARDS FOR U.S. STUDENTS

Mandarin-taught Master's Degree Program Awards

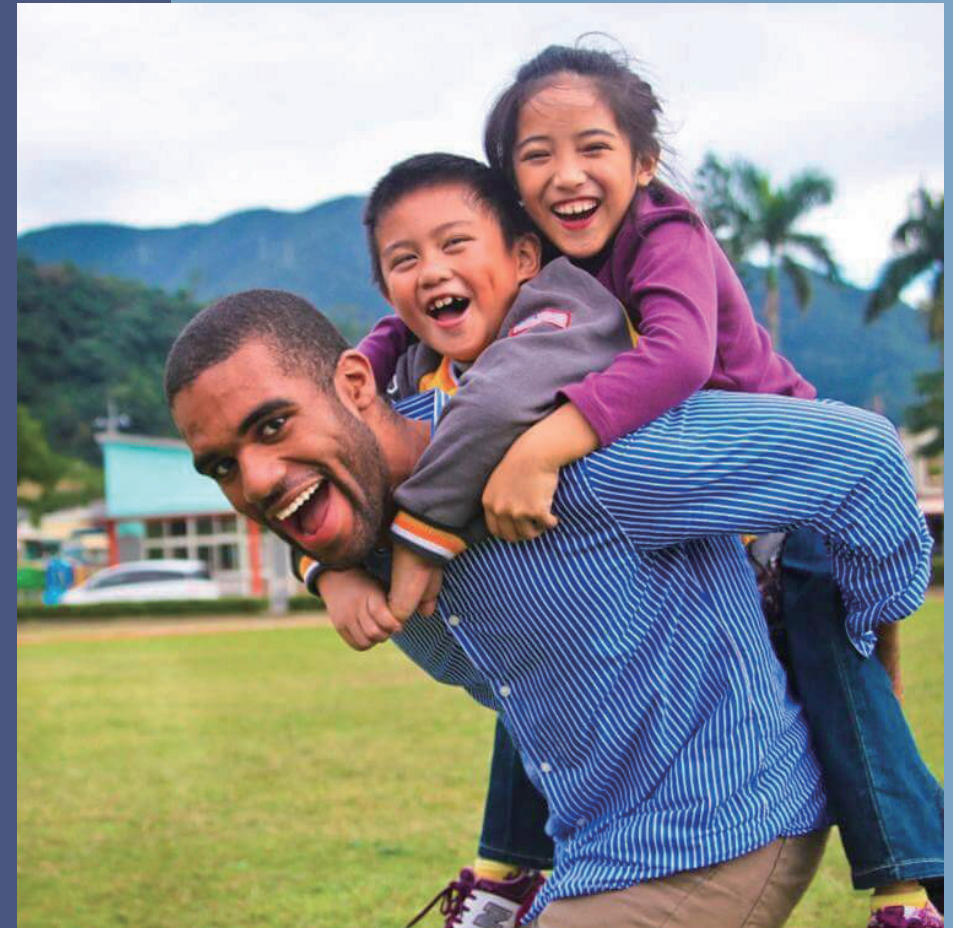
- └ One-year intensive Mandarin learning
- └ Two-years professional studies

Awards are for **3 years*** to Master's degree studies taught in Mandarin, with the requirement of learning advance Mandarin in the 1st year.

The award provides grantees with a 100% tuition waiver, campus housing, a monthly stipend, National Health Insurance, and round-trip airfare.

Eligibility: At least a Bachelor's degree at time of matriculation, and Chinese language level equivalent to higher intermediate at time of application: ACTFL- Intermediate High, New HSK- 5, CEFR- B1, or TBCL 4

*The Master's Degree in Translation and Interpretation is for **2 years** to study translation/interpretation in a Mandarin-immersion environment.





Chinese Medicine

- ✓ China Medical University (中國醫藥大學)

Integration of Chinese and Western medicine while having opportunities to learn Chinese traditional medicine and to observe the clinical practice.

Ethnic Relations & Cultures

- ✓ National Dong Hua University (國立東華大學)

With rich resources in Taiwan indigenous and Austronesian cultures.



Diplomacy

- ✓ National Chengchi University (國立政治大學)

One of the best ways to learn U.S.-China-Taiwan relations under Chinese-language context in Asia.

History

- ✓ National Cheng Kung University (國立成功大學)

Located in the historical capital of the heart of Asia Tainan, with specializations in history of China and Taiwan.





Teaching Chinese as a Second/Foreign Language

- ✓ National Taiwan Normal University (國立臺灣師範大學)

The oldest program in Taiwan to train teachers of Mandarin.



- ✓ Tunghai University (東海大學)

The first program in Taiwan that is designed for international students to be trained as teachers of Mandarin.



- ✓ National Kaohsiung Normal University (國立高雄師範大學)

Special programs in AR/VR technology and international school.



- ✓ National Chinan University (國立暨南大學)

Rich resources in South East Asian languages and cultures.



- ✓ Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages (文藻大學)

The only university of languages in Taiwan.



International Sinology

- ✓ National Tsing Hua University (國立清華大學)

Equipping students with the proficiency of "Advanced Chinese and Basic Sinology", with the resources provided by the departments of Chinese Literature, Taiwan Literature, Sinophone Studies, History, Sociology, and Anthropology.



Translation and Interpretation (2 years award)

- ✓ National Taiwan Normal University (國立臺灣師範大學)

Taiwan's premiere program in Chinese-English translation/interpretation.





AWARDS FOR U.S. STUDENTS



English Teaching Assistant Award (ETA) FSE X MOE English Teaching Flagship Award (ETF)

The Fulbright ETA and FSE X MOE ETF awards foster mutual understanding between the people of the United States and Taiwan. ETA/ETFs provide a native speaker presence in schools, thus improving foreign students' English language abilities.

Additionally, ETA/ETFs serve as cultural ambassadors, sharing knowledge of the United States while enhancing the U.S. student's own language skills and knowledge of Taiwan. The award facilitates not only English language learning, but also cross-cultural exchange.



Opportunities to Host Taiwan Fulbrighters

For more than 75 years, the Fulbright Program has provided higher education institutions across the United States with opportunities to reinforce campus internationalization strategies, build global networks, launch professional collaborations, and share culture and values.

Fulbright participants conduct cutting-edge research and unique teaching skills and bring fresh perspectives that benefit campuses and communities as they engage in a complex and changing world.



Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program

After applying in their home countries, approximately 900 faculty and professionals from more than 100 countries receive Fulbright grants each year to conduct research and/or teach in the United States. The Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program campus links around the world and introduces new ideas and networks to students, faculty, and administrators.

Fulbright Scholar-in-Residence (S-I-R) Program

The Fulbright S-I-R Program provides U.S. colleges and universities with opportunities to host scholars from other countries for a semester or an academic year. Fulbright S-I-Rs teach primarily at the undergraduate level, collaborate with faculty and administrators, and interact with the campus and local community.

What should a U.S. institution do?

A Fulbright SIR application to IIE, which indicates that you want to have a Taiwan scholar!





Fulbright Outreach Lecturing Fund (OLF)

The Outreach Lecturing Fund provides funding for U.S. institutions to host Fulbright Visiting Scholars and Scholars-in-Residence who are already in the United States for **short-term speaking engagements**.

Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistant (FLTA) Program

U.S. institutions of higher education apply to host foreign language teaching assistants to support foreign language instruction on campus and enhance students' understanding of other cultures.

What should a U.S. institution do?

A Fulbright FLTA application to IIE, which indicates that you want to have a Taiwan FLTA!
