International Education administrators in universities/colleges come to Taiwan to explore the opportunities of establishing cooperation with local institutions by visiting various sites in 2 weeks.






AWARDS FOR U.S. STUDENTS

English-taught Master's Degree Program Awards

Awards are for 2 years to **Master's** degree studies **taught in English**, with the opportunity to learn Mandarin supported by Fulbright Taiwan.

The award provides grantees with a 100% tuition waiver, campus housing, a monthly stipend, National Health Insurance, and round-trip airfare.

Eligibility: At least a Bachelor's degree at time of matriculation






















AWARDS FOR U.S. STUDENTS

Mandarin-taught Master's Degree Program Awards

- **—** One-year intensive Mandarin learning
- _ Two-years professional studies

Awards are for **3 years*** to Master's degree studies taught in Mandarin, with the requirement of learning advance Mandarin in the 1st year.

The award provides grantees with a 100% tuition waiver, campus housing, a monthly stipend, National Health Insurance, and round-trip airfare.

Eligibility: At least a Bachelor's degree at time of matriculation, and Chinese language level equivalent to higher intermediate at time of application: ACTFL- Intermediate High, New HSK- 5, CEFR- B1, or TBCL 4

*The Master's Degree in Translation and Interpretation is for **2 years** to study translation/interpretation in a Mandarin-immersion environment.

✓ Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages (文藻大學)


The only university of languages in Taiwan.

The Fulbright ETA and FSE x MOE ETF awards foster mutual understanding between the people of the United States and Taiwan. ETA/ ETFs provide an American English-speaking presence in schools, helping to improve students' language proficiency and motivating them to use English more confidently.

In addition to language instruction, ETA/ETFs serve as cultural ambassadors, sharing knowledge about the United States while deepening their understanding of Taiwan. These awards promote not only English language learning but also meaningful cross-cultural exchange.

Furthermore, the Fulbright Debate Coach/Trainer Award invites experienced American debate coaches to support the development of debate programs in Taiwan's senior high schools. This initiative aims to strengthen English education, raise students' awareness of global issues, and cultivate critical thinking skills essential for becoming engaged global citizens.

AWARDS FOR GRADE 1-12 TEACHERS

The Fulbright Distinguished Award in Teaching Research Program (Fulbright DA) provides funding for highly accomplished U.S. primary and secondary level educators to take part in an intensive professional development program for four months in Taiwan.

Grantees will study at a host university or institution in Taiwan and conduct an education project related to their professional interests. Additional activities in local schools include opportunities to observe classes, team teach or conduct seminars or workshops.





Opportunities to Host Taiwan Fulbrighters

For more than 75 years, the Fulbright Program has provided higher education institutions across the United States with opportunities to reinforce campus internationalization strategies, build global networks, launch professional collaborations, and share culture and values.

Fulbright participants conduct cutting-edge research and unique teaching skills and bring fresh perspectives that benefit campuses and communities as they engage in a complex and changing world.



Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program

After applying in their home countries, approximately 900 faculty and professionals from more than 100 countries receive Fulbright grants each year to conduct research and/or teach in the United States. The Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program campus links around the world and introduces new ideas and networks to students, faculty, and administrators.

Fulbright Scholar-in-Residence (S-I-R) Program

The Fulbright S-I-R Program provides U.S. colleges and universities with opportunities to host scholars from other countries for a semester or an academic year. Fulbright S-I-Rs teach primarily at the undergraduate level, collaborate with faculty and administrators, and interact with the campus and local community.

What should a U.S. institution do?

A Fulbright SIR application to IIE, which indicates that you want to have a Taiwan scholar



Fulbright Outreach Lecturing Fund (OLF)

The Outreach Lecturing Fund provides funding for U.S. institutions to host Fulbright Visiting Scholars and Scholars-in-Residence who are already in the United States for **short-term speaking engagements**.

Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistant (FLTA) Program

U.S. institutions of higher education apply to host foreign language teaching assistants to support foreign language instruction on campus and enhance students' understanding of other cultures.

What should a U.S. institution do?

A Fulbright FLTA application to IIE, which indicates that you want to have a Taiwan FLTA!


